
## How to get to Atsugi city?

There are two ways we recommend you to use.

## From Narita Airport to Atsugi Area



## By Limousine Bus

Easier way is to take direct limousine bus to Atsugi area. Please refer the bus schedule below. You want to come to Hon-Atsugi station, where your hotel is reserved. You can also use bus goes to Sagami-Ono since it is only two stops away by Express train to Hon-Atsugi station (240yen).

Bus ticket counter is right outside of the immigration exit on the arrival lobby. Either Terminal 1 or 2, you will find them easily after you pass the custom. There are several bus companies running to various directions. Please be sure to choose the bus running to Sagami-Ono or Hon-Atsugi. Price for both is 3,500yen and it usually takes two and half hours depend on traffic. Please be aware that Tokyo is notorious for its traffic jam and evening rush hour is awful.

## By Train

Please take JR Narita Express to Shinjuku station and then onto Odakyu's express train to Hon-Atsugi. To Shinjuku is about 70 minutes and 3,110yen. Train station is on the underground level at Narita. After arriving at Shinjuku station, you transfer to Odakyu line. Both are in the same building, but have separate gates. Buy Odakyu ticket of 480yen to Hon-Atsugi at a vending machine. After the gate, Odakyu Shinjuku station has two-departure-floor, upper is for Express train and lower for Local train. Take Express (kyuko) on upper floor. There are also semi-express (jyunkyu) and super-express (tokkyu), but it will be easy to stick to Express. It leaves every 10 minutes from platform 4 and 5, and takes 50min. to Hon-Atsugi. After 40minutes ride, Express arrives Sagami-Ono station where train splits to two directions. Usually the first six cars go to Odawara or Hakone-Yumoto, which is your direction, and the latter four cars go to Enoshima. There are other patterns too, so please make sure by asking people near you.
